

Sandaraska Park - Policies

Occupancy: The price of camping on any of the standard sites includes 2 adults, 2 children, and is permitted a single sleeping unit. In Pine Alley, two pen sites include 2 adults, 2 children, 2 horses and the three pen sites include 3 adults, 2 children, 3 horses. Each site in Pine Alley is permitted two trailers (either horse trailer, travel trailer, pop-up, etc.) and their tow vehicles to be parked on the site. Additional trailers/vehicles can be parked in the back lot.

Pine Alley: Campers in Pine Alley will be charged a \$100 clean-up fee if horse waste is left behind in the pens. Individuals with horses are required to sign agreeing to the [Acknowledgement of Risk and Release of Liability](#) form prior to check in.

Standard of Care: Temporary horse pens of any kind are not allowed and you must create your reservation to allow each horse you are bringing to have their own pen. This applied to any additional guests. Campers are responsible for the care, well-being, and clean-up of their horses, as well as of their visitors, at all times on park property. Management reserves the right to remove any trailer or campers and cancel a reservation if there are signs of neglect.

Check-in & Check-out Times: Check-out is 11 AM and check-in is 2 PM. If you arrive early, the office can permit you to access the site early, but only if it was vacant the night before. We do not offer late check out.

Responsibility and Etiquette: Registered campers are responsible at all times for the safety and conduct of their family and any visitors to their lot. Occupants and guests must respect the property and privacy of other individuals in the park. Do not walk or drive across other sites. Abuse of any staff will not be tolerated and will lead to eviction. This includes verbal abuse, threats, and disrespectful behavior. The various jobs of park staff are to ensure enjoyment for everyone and they are to be treated with dignity and respect. Park Management reserves the right to remove any trailer or any campers due to lack of cooperation or violation of park rules.

Quiet Hours: 11:00 PM – 8:00 AM. This is a family campground, so please be considerate of other guests. All children under the age of 16 must be on their lot by 10:00 PM or accompanied by an adult. Music may be played outside of the quiet hours, but must not be a disturbance to others at any time!

Dirt bikes & ATVs: Are not permitted to be ridden in the park. To access the Ganaraska trails, you can trailer them to either the Porter Rd parking lot or our back parking lot at the end of Trailside.

Ganaraska Forest: Even though the GRCA is an entirely separate entity, anyone caught disobeying their rules will be ejected from the park and your reservation will be cancelled. See "conditions of use" on www.ganaraskaforestcentre.ca.

Swimming Pool: We do not have a lifeguard at the pool at all times. Your child's safety is your responsibility. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by someone over the age of 16. The posted rules must be adhered to at all times. Parents/guardians will be held responsible for the actions of their children.

Theft & Vandalism: In the event that an occupants, their family, visitors, or invitees are caught vandalizing or defacing park property or stealing, their trailer will be evicted from the park without refund.

Camp Fires: Must be contained in the ring provided at the front of the lot. Please do not move the fire ring. Occupants must have a means of extinguishment and no fire is to be left unattended. Do not burn garbage of any kind.

Fireworks & Firearms: No fireworks, firearms, airguns, slingshots, bow/arrows are permitted on park property.

Garbage: Please use the garbage and recycling disposal bins located at the main entrance across from the park office. Disposal of larger items such as furniture or appliances is prohibited and will be returned to the owner.

Pets: We love having your pets here! They must always be on a leash at all times and they must be kept under control. Please clean up after them and be considerate of others.

Visitors: All visitors to your site must register and pay at the main office before being able to enter the park.

Wood: No wood may be brought into the park. All firewood must be purchased from the park office due to the spread of destructive pests.
